This By-Law has been passed by a majority of not less than three fourths of the members present and voting in person or via proxy in a General Meeting. This policy should be read in conjunction with the Club Constitution and other relevant Regulations, Codes, Policies, and Documents

1. Purpose

This agreement is for a parent, Guardians or Supervising Adult of junior handlers between 10 -16 years of age that are involved in the training of a dog at the Club. It places obligations on the parent / Guardian / Supervising Adult to ensure that they be physically present and to supervise their child whilst the child is handling a dog during all sanctioned Club events.

2. Agreement

The following rules apply to junior handlers wishing to join the Club:

- ✍ A parent / guardian or supervising adult must always attend the junior handler's nominated class.
- ✍ Junior handlers may only train a dog after completing an assessment to determine the suitability of the size and temperament of the dog in relation to the size and age of the junior handler. The assessment will be conducted by the Supervisor of Training and one other instructor of the Club whose decision is final.
